EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

PROBLEM STATEMENT

Key Issues

Food Insecurity

A significant number of children attend school without reliable access to meals, affecting concentration, energy levels, and overall health.

Unsafe or Unstable Living Conditions

Some children lack consistent or safe spaces for rest, impacting physical and emotional well-being.

Inadequate Learning Environments

Schools may lack basic infrastructure such as desks, seating, and structured classroom environments.

Limited Access to Educational Materials

Students often lack essential tools needed to participate fully in learning.

PROPOSED SOLUTION
